## **Audition components**

#### Scales

- Students are required to prepare all 12 major scales (quarter = 92 played in straight eighth notes) as well as the chromatic scale. They will be asked to play 2 major scales and the chromatic
- All scales must be memorized
- Refer to starting pitch and minimum range chart below

## Audition Etude

- Students should adhere to suggested tempi

# Sight Reading

- Students will be asked to sight read a short excerpt
- Percussionist will be asked to sight read on mallets

#### Note for percussion

- Percussion Students auditioning on percussion will be required to play all mallet, snare drum, timpani and multiple percussion etudes.
- Percussion students must demonstrate the ability to tune timpani
- Auxiliary percussion etude is below
